We will welcome you to a historic local vinegar factory, where, in addition to an extensive tasting, all the secrets regarding the production of vinegar will be revealed, and you will be recommended a few simple recipes to try with your family when you return home. The last part of the day will be dedicated to another symbol of Italian excellence: a visit to the famous Ferrari Museum in Maranello, in celebration of the now legendary Prancing Horse. Come admire the famous automobile manufacturer's classic flame red cars up close and personal, and relive the legend through an exhibition of pictures, vintage cars, Formula One single-seaters and trophies won by the Ferrari team around the world since the beginning of their career. And, if you want, you can also drive your favourite model of Ferrari\*!
